

Birthday Party Package Rules

- 1. Deposits will be fully refunded if cleanup is acceptable, no damage is noted to the facility or equipment, and all policies have been followed. The renter must sign a rental checklist before leaving the facility in order to have the damage deposit returned. Renters exceeding the rental time are charged at 2 times the hourly rental rate, which will be deducted from the deposit.
- 2. Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- 3. No live amplified music, candles, or open flames allowed.
- 4. Adults must supervise children at all times.
- 5. You are responsible for returning tables and chairs to their original location. Furniture is for indoor use only.
- 6. All food, decorations, and supplies brought into the center for the party are to be removed. You must leave the room(s) arranged as you found them.
- 7. Balloons must be weighted or tied down and then removed from the building at the end of your rental.
- 8. All decorations must be flame-proof or fire retardant. Decorations must be applied with blue painter's tape only, and may not be hung from light fixtures, ceilings, fans, heat detectors, or emergency lights.
- 9. Party changes must be requested 30 days in advance. A refund is granted if the request is made at least 30 days prior to the start of the party, less a \$25 nonrefundable booking fee. There are no refunds or transfer of dates/times given with less than 30 days' notice.
- 10. If the building is not open at the time you reserved, verify start time on your contract, and then contact the Kirkland Parks after-hours phone, 425-864-3431. A facility attendant will be sent.
